

Participants use products they find on the market – there is a lack of awareness about whether these products are environmentally friendly or not.

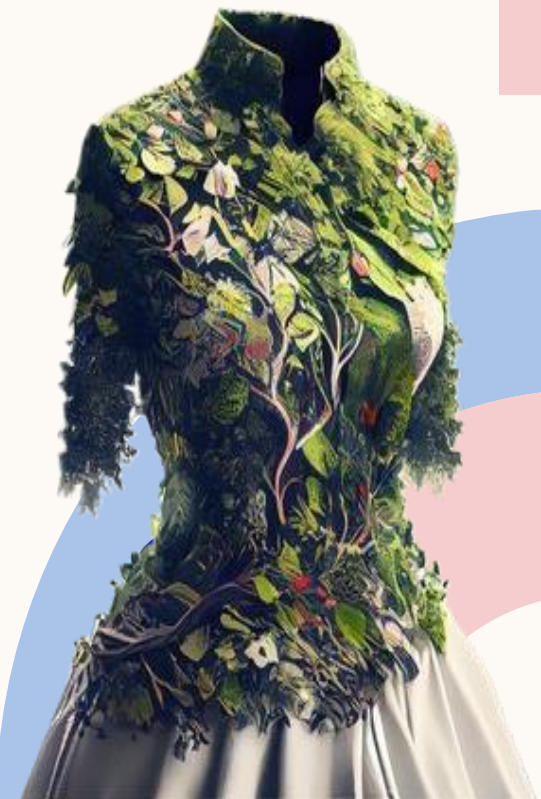
$\frac{3}{4}$ of participants are willing to spend slightly more money to buy environmentally friendly products.

OUR WAY FORWARD

1. Spread awareness about sustainable fashion to the entire school community during assemblies and school activities.
2. Set up the school's Thrift Shop once again.
3. Invite speakers and skilled people to school to share their knowledge on sustainable fashion, as well as their expertise in sewing and re-purposing clothes.
4. Donate any clothes to local shelters, following the school's Thrift Shop.
5. Take part in national campaigns for sustainability, such as the 'Young Reporters for the Environment' (YRE) and the Litterless Campaign.
6. Work on portfolios for students who have formed part of EkoSkola for a minimum of 2 years, for which an MQF 2-3 accreditation will be given. This will serve as an additional SEC/O'Level result for the students.
